

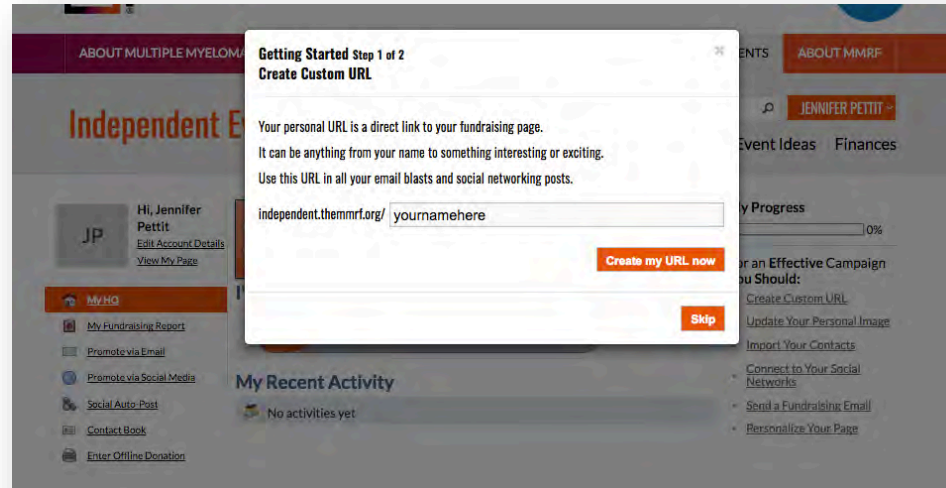

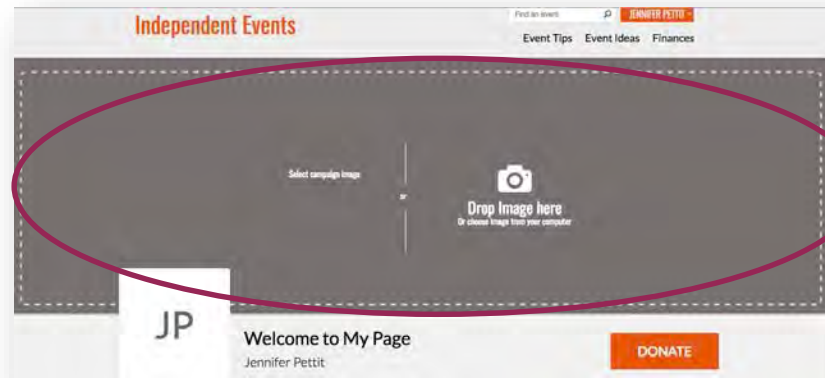

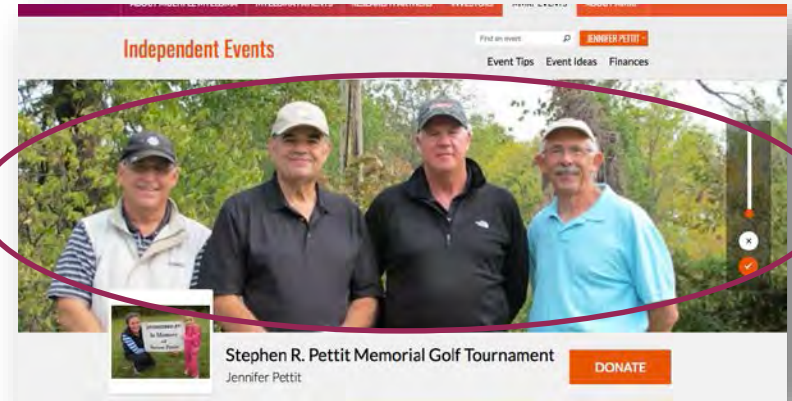
Event Fundraising Page: “My HQ”

Tips:

- **Uploading Pictures (Top Image):** At the Top of the Page You can Upload or Drag a Drop an Image for Your Event

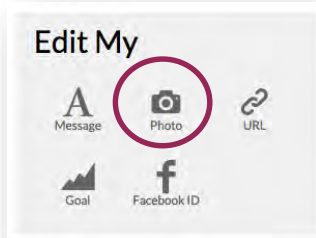

Event Fundraising Page: “My HQ”

Tips:

- **Uploading Pictures (Small Image):** Underneath your large top picture, you can upload a small profile image by clicking on your initials (this example “JP”) or by clicking on “Photo” in the “Edit My” section

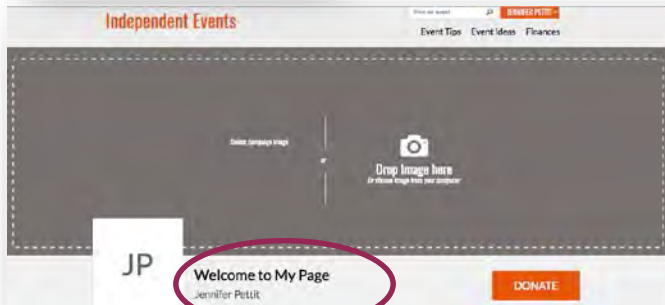
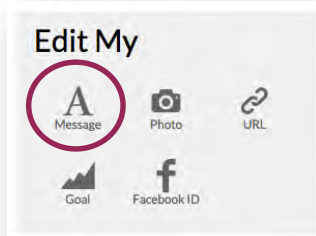

Tips:

- **Updating the Title of Your Page:** Next to the smaller profile picture you can edit the default copy of “Welcome to My Page” to your Event name by clicking on “Message” in the “Edit My” box

Event Fundraising Page: “My HQ”

Tips:

- **Updating Copy:** Each event page is pre-populated with information about the MMRF, but we also *strongly encourage* you to include details about your event:
 - Why you are supporting the MMRF (example: personal connection to myeloma, “My dad was diagnosed with multiple myeloma in 2015 and we are hosting a golf tournament in his honor”
 - Details about the event (date, time, location)
 - How to contact you
- To do this click “Message” in the “Edit My” box

This year, I will be hosting the annual Stephen R. Pettit Golf Tournament to raise critical funds for MMRF in memory of our dad. I am committed to raising awareness and funds to accelerate finding a cure for multiple myeloma, which is the second most common blood cancer and is currently incurable. Your generosity truly makes a difference.

Funds raised through MMRF events have helped to:

- Nearly triple patient survival
- Deliver ten new treatments in a decade
- Launch over 60 new clinical trials

The MMRF was established in 1998 as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization by twin sisters Karen Andrews and Kathy Givati, soon after Kathy's diagnosis with multiple myeloma. The mission of the MMRF is to relentlessly pursue innovative means that accelerate the development of next-generation multiple myeloma treatments to extend the lives of patients and lead to a cure. The MMRF, along with its research and medical industry partners, has fueled more studies, initiated more trials, developed more treatments, introduced more medicines, and have had a far greater impact than any other organization on myeloma.

The MMRF is one of the most highly regarded cancer foundations in the world. Nearly 90% of the MMRF total budget goes directly towards research and related programming. The MMRF has received the "Best in America" Seal of Excellence from the Independent Charities of America and Charity Navigator's 4-star rating for the past twelve years in a row. The MMRF has also been recognized by Philanthropedia as one of 16 expert-identified, high-impact nonprofits in the field of cancer."
